		GET YOUR FEIN In order to get a business license, you will need to obtain a Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) from the IRS. FEIN's are free and can be obtained online. Visit: www.irs.gov, and type in FEIN in the search box.
		You'll need the FEIN in order to finish the registration for the business license, so be sure to write it down when it comes up on the IRS screen. A hard copy

will be sent to you via mail as well.

- Can be obtained in the Building and Zoning Office on the 4th floor of the City Municipal Building. Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by the applicable code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall obtain a building permit before the work has begun.

Then, the business would need to bring in a set of blueprints, copies of contractor's licenses + liability insurance, fill out a permit application and remit a \$10 fee plus \$2 per thousand of development.

APPLY FOR A SALES TAX NUMBER IF NEEDED

- Who needs a sales tax permit in West Virginia?
 Retailers doing business in West Virginia need a sales tax permit. You can find out what conditions create sales tax nexus in West Virginia here.
- 2. How do you register for a sales tax permit in West Virginia?

 You can complete the form WV/BUS-APP found in this booklet or register online at Business for West Virginia.
- 3. What information do you need to register for a sales tax permit in West Virginia?
 - Personal identification info (SSN, address, etc.)
 - Business identification info (EIN, address, etc.) Always use your home business or business address, even if you are located outside West Virginia.
 - NAICS code
 - Date you began doing business in West Virginia (Not sure what to enter here? Read more about "When to Register for a Sales Tax Permit")
- 4. How much does it cost to apply for a sales tax permit in West Virginia?

 It's free to apply for a sales tax permit, but other West Virginia business registration fees may apply. Some businesses based in West Virginia may be required to pay a \$30 business registration fee. You can find out more about that here.
- 5. How long does it take to receive your West Virginia sales tax permit?

 West Virginia doesn't specify how long it takes to receive your sales tax permit, but for most states it's within 2-3 weeks at most.
- 6. Do you have to renew your West Virginia sales tax permit?
 You do not need to renew your West Virginia sales tax permit.

REGISTER A TRADEMARK FOR YOUR BUSINESS NAME OR APPLY FOR A PATENT OR PROVISIONAL PATENT FOR INVENTIONS (IF APPLICABLE)
 To register a trademark, go to the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office's Web site, www.uspto.gov.
 * You can file online with the copyright office and pay a \$35 fee, or you can register your work by submitting a Form CO and a non-returnable copy of your work along with a \$50 fee. Keep in mind that if you register online, the Library of Congress still needs hard copies of a "best edition" of your work. (Info from Rocket Lawyer)
GET APPROPRIATE BUSINESS INSURANCE FOR YOUR BUSINESS
INQUIRE ABOUT WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE AND UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE IF YOU WILL BE HIRING EMPLOYEES
ARRANGE FOR HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE IF NEEDED
OPEN A BANK ACCOUNT IN THE BUSINESS NAME
ORDER BUSINESS CHECKS (WITH THE NAME IMPRINTED)
HAVE A BUSINESS PHONE LINE INSTALLED IF YOU WILL BE WORKING FROM HOME
ORDER PHONE, INTERNET AND ANY UTILITY SERVICES NEEDED FOR A BUSINESS LOCATION THAT ISNT HOMEBASED
TALK TO AN ACCOUNTANT ABOUT YOUR TAX OBLIGATIONS & RECORD KEEPING REQUIREMENTS
SET UP AN ACCOUNTING SYSTEM OR ACCOUNTING SOFTWARE FOR THE BUSINESS

HAVE A LOGO CREATED
ORDER BUSINESS CARDS, ENVELOPES AND STATIONERY FOR THE BUSINESS. (if needed. Alternately, print them yourself, if you have the capability.)

ORDER INVENTORY
FIND A WEBSITE HOSTING COMPANY OR CLOUDBASED STOREFRONT PROVIDER AND SET UP YOUR SITE
SET UP A BUSINESS EMAIL ADDRESS (PREFERABLY USING THE BUSINESS DOMAIN NAME)
SET UP SOCIAL MEDIA PAGES FOR THE BUSINESS & LIST HOURS OF OPERATION • Google, Facebook, LinkedIn, Instagram, etc.
START BUILDING A PERMISSION-BASED CUSTOMER EMAIL LIST FOR NEWSLETTERS AND PROMOTIONS • The Wood County Economic Development office uses MailChimp and Downtown PKB uses Constant Contact, but there are others out there as well!
PREPARE BROCHURES, FLIERS AND OTHER HANDOUTS. PRINT OR ORDER A SMALL QUANTITY TO PROMOTE YOUR BUSINESS OPENING

DECIDE WHERE AND HOW TO ADVERTISE YOUR BUSINESS

OTHER: IF OPENING A RESTAURANT:
1. Contact the health department to acquire a plan review form, this form must be submitted 45 days in advance of construction.

2. Submit an application to operate to the health department at least one week before opening.

3. Complete a walk through approximately one week before opening in order to give the owner
