

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME (2013-2017)



WV VEHICLE INSPECTIONS

West Virginia requires a routine safety inspection on every vehicle every twelve (12) months. Vehicles may be inspected at any official inspection station licensed by the West Virginia State Police. When a vehicle passes the inspection, a sticker valid for twelve (12) months will be placed on the inside of the windshield. It is illegal to drive a vehicle without a valid inspection sticker.

HOW LONG DO YOU HAVE TO OBTAIN AN INSPECTION

New residents have 10 days from the date they title a vehicle to have a West Virginia inspection. This also includes the purchase of vehicles out of state. West Virginia has reciprocity with Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, New Hampshire, New York, Oklahoma, Texas, Utah and Wyoming. Therefore, out-of-state inspection stickers from these states are valid in West Virginia until expiration.

Any vehicle purchased or otherwise acquired within West Virginia not having a valid inspection sticker must be inspected within three days.

WHAT YOU NEED TO OBTAIN AN INSPECTION

You must have a valid registration card and a current certificate of insurance in the vehicle at the time of inspection.

COST OF THE INSPECTIONS

A fee of no more than \$14.65 sales tax may be charged for an inspection and the issuance of the certificate of inspection. (\$11 labor plus sales tax for labor, + \$3 for certificate.)

INSPECTION FAILURES

Any vehicle which fails to meet the requirements for approval will be issued a rejection sticker by the inspector mechanic. Such rejections will be recorded on the MVI-5 (log sheet) or MVI-5A. IMPORTANT—Only one (1) rejection sticker can be issued to a vehicle no matter how many stations inspect a vehicle. If a station has issued a rejection sticker to a vehicle, and the vehicle is taken to another station for inspection, the rejection sticker will be removed only if the vehicle passes inspection.

ITEMS TO BE INSPECTED

The following items must be thoroughly examined, according to the regulations to constitute an official inspection. Failure to comply will be regarded as a faulty inspection.

- 1. Verify legal registration.
- 2. Check certificate of insurance.
- 3. Remove old sticker.
- 4. Check safety glass.
- 5. Check sheet metal, bumpers, fenders and frame.
- 6. Check horn, rearview mirror, windshield wipers and plate mounting.
- 7. Check brake system, i.e., service and emergency brake, brake linings, brake pedal and all hoses.
- 8. Check front-end and steering components.
- 9. Check exhaust system and fuel system.
- 10. Check tires and wheels.
- 11. Check lights, safety devices and seat belts.
- 12. Affix sticker.

DUTIES OF THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

The Wood County Sheriff's Office has many duties. It is responsible for collecting taxes, civil process service, enforcing the law, providing security for local courts, providing road patrol to the rural areas of Wood County, overseeing the Holding Center, and transporting prisoners to the Regional Jail. The Sheriff's Office is comprised of 37 Deputies, including Sheriff Steve Stephens, and 11 contract officers. Tax collection is now done at the newly renovated Judge Black Annex (previously Town Square).

ARE YOU OK? PROGRAM

The "Are You OK?" program is possible by a grant awarded by the Parkersburg Area Community Foundation; fund from the Wood County Sheriff's Concealed Weapons Fund; and support from the Wood County Commission. Now "at risk" individuals or adults with a disability in Wood County can feel safer and more secure with a daily phone call to confirm all is well or to summon assistance if needed. This is a free service provided by the Wood County Sheriff's Office.

HOW DOES THE "ARE YOU OK?" PROGRAM WORK?

- 1 An automatic phone system will call you at the same time everyday, you choose the time.
- 2 System is voice-activated, only say "Hello".
- 3 You will hear the following message, "This is the Wood County Sheriff's Office "Are You OK?" program."
- 4 If you are OK, you will be given a specific number to press on your phone.
- 5 Once you press the number requested, the computer will know that you are OK.
- 6 After 4 unsuccessful attempts, an emergency contact is alerted and sent to your residence to check on you.
- 7 You will need to call if you will not be home at the time we are set up to call you.

- Sign up and complete a confidential information form.
- 2 You will be asked for your date of birth or social security number.
- $\frac{3}{3}$ We will ask for emergency contacts, pets in house, doctors, clergy and a brief medical history.


DOWNTOWN THROWDOWN
